Mr. Wade House, because of his interest in the study of ancient man, organized a club in 1953 to share this study with interested students. Through the club, it is possible for a member to go on several sponsored weekend trips to local ranches to hunt for artifacts and one two-day trip to the Indian mounds area north of Uvalde. The year's activities are topped off by a week-long trip in the summer to the Indian caves near Langtry and Pandale.

Club meetings are held semi-monthly during Activity period in school. These meetings are lively discussions of each member's recent finds. New members who are interested are welcomed each year.
