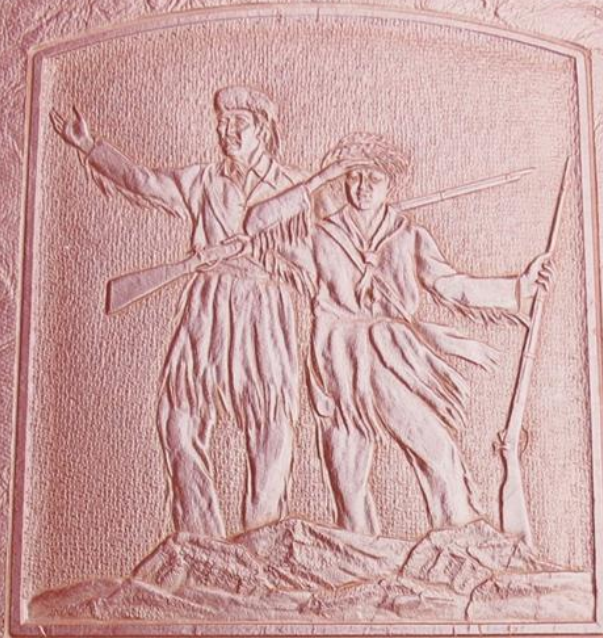

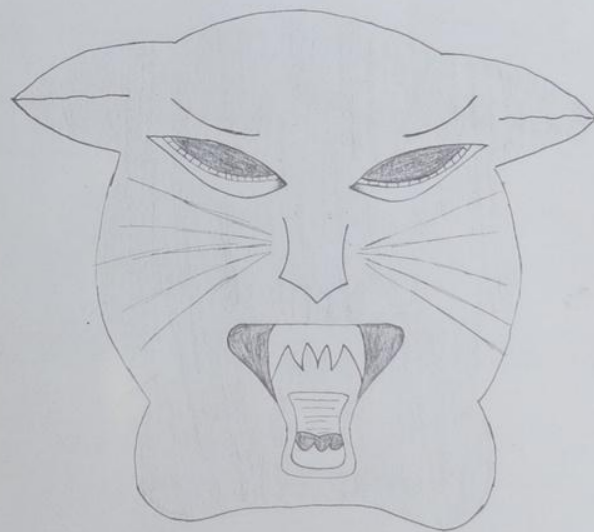

FOREWORD

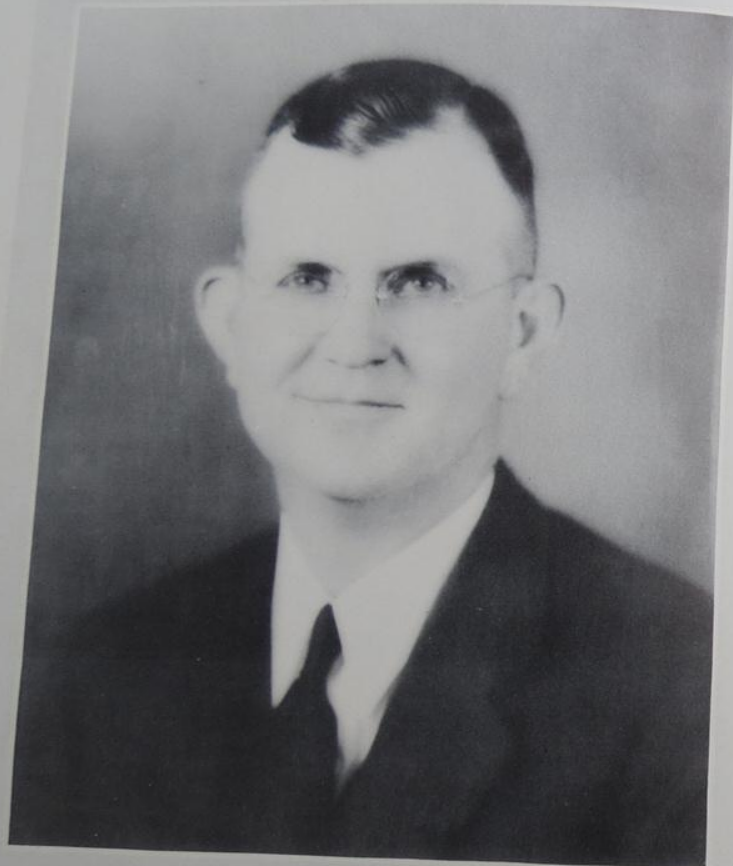
*"The Wildcat" Staff of 1936

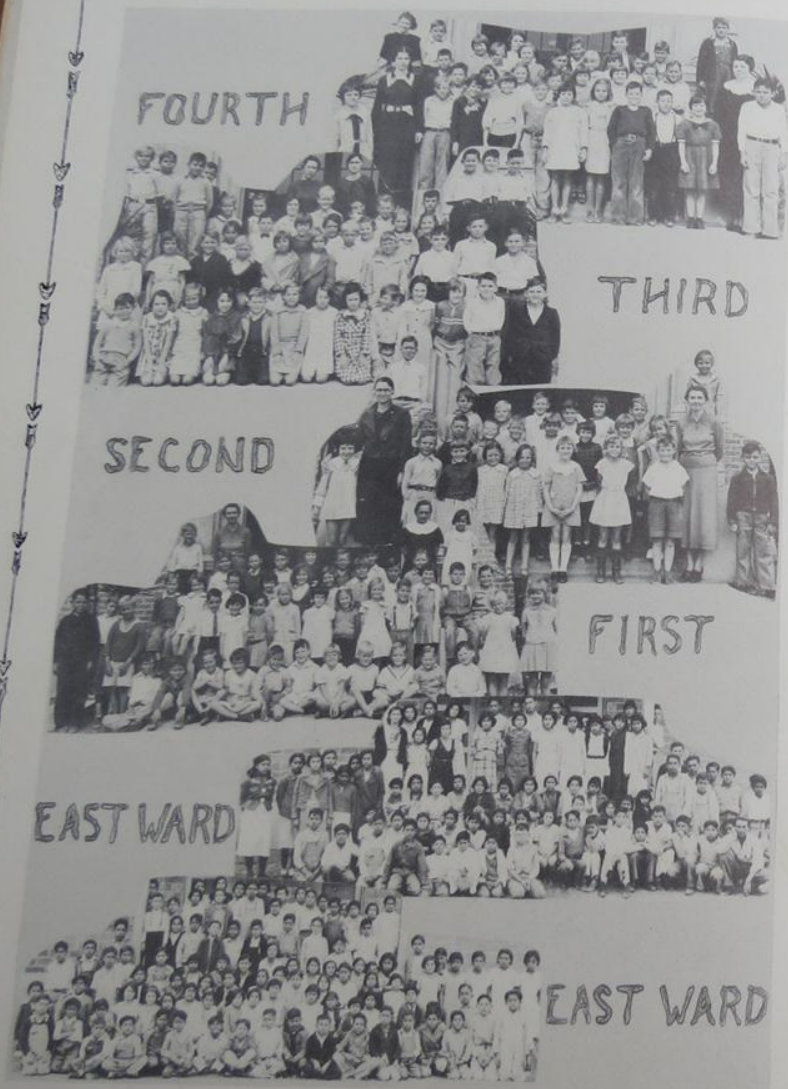

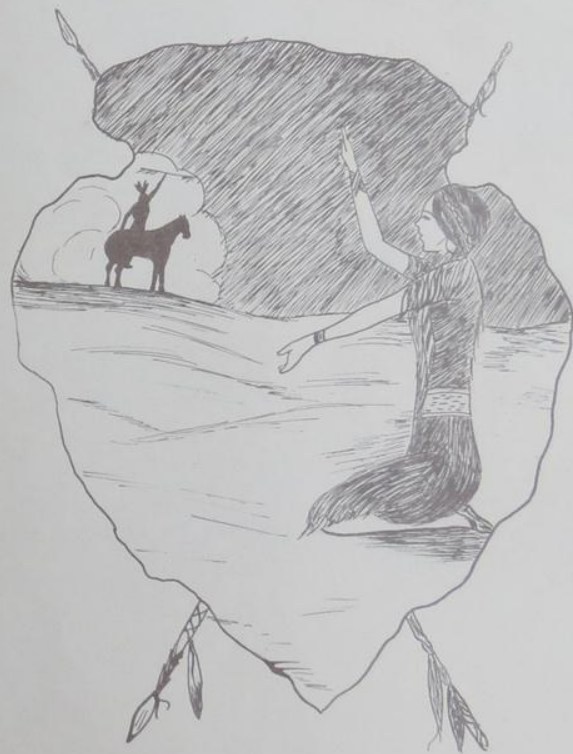

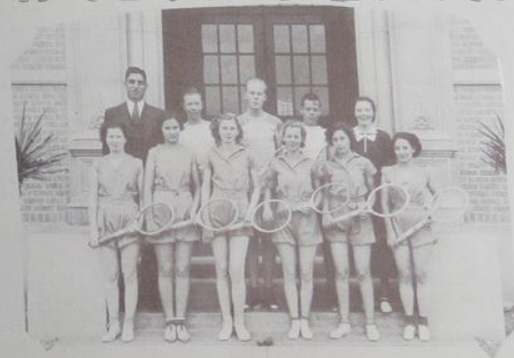
