- These photos were sent to our school district on March 31, 2005 along with a letter from attorney William D. Tate of Grapevine, Texas. He states that these were among the personal effects of R.C. Patterson and his wife Mary Belle. He states that Mr. Patterson was a teacher here in Carrizo Springs when he began his career. Next slide includes his letter.
- There are two 1st Grade photos and no 8th Grade photo. I believe the photographer wrote the wrong grade level on one of the 1st Grade photos and it's really 2nd grade. If so, then all of the grade levels would be one higher than indicated and there would be an 8th grade photo. We may never know.
- The two East Side School photos are at the beginning. The East Side School was the segregated school that educated Hispanics.
