

Carrizo Springs Varsity Concert Choir had a very interesting year. The choir, under the direction of Mr. Gareld Payne, performed various concerts throughout the year. The choir sang the national anthem and the school song along with the newly added alma mater. This was first performed at the homecoming football game. The newly formed Choraliers also performed for Homecoming. They sang excerpts

from the musical, "Oklahoma". The Choraliers were: Kelly Howard, Dalia Jaime, Edna Marroquin, Ruth Espinoza, Stella Martinez, Roy Ortiz, Sammy Embers, David Rizer, Robert Dickens, and Randy Dickerson. This group was sent to Kerrville in November to represent our school in Area tryouts. Out of these ten, Stella and Robert made All-Area and advanced to State tryouts held in January. Concert Contest held in Fredericksburg proved to be tough. The choir made a V (five) in Concert; and a IV (four) in Sight-reading. Soloists did much better capturing a number of II (two) ratings, a few III (three) ratings and one I (Superior) rating. Dalia Jaime rated a I with her Class II solo.
