## 1993-94 4-H

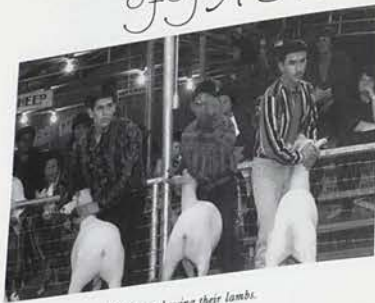

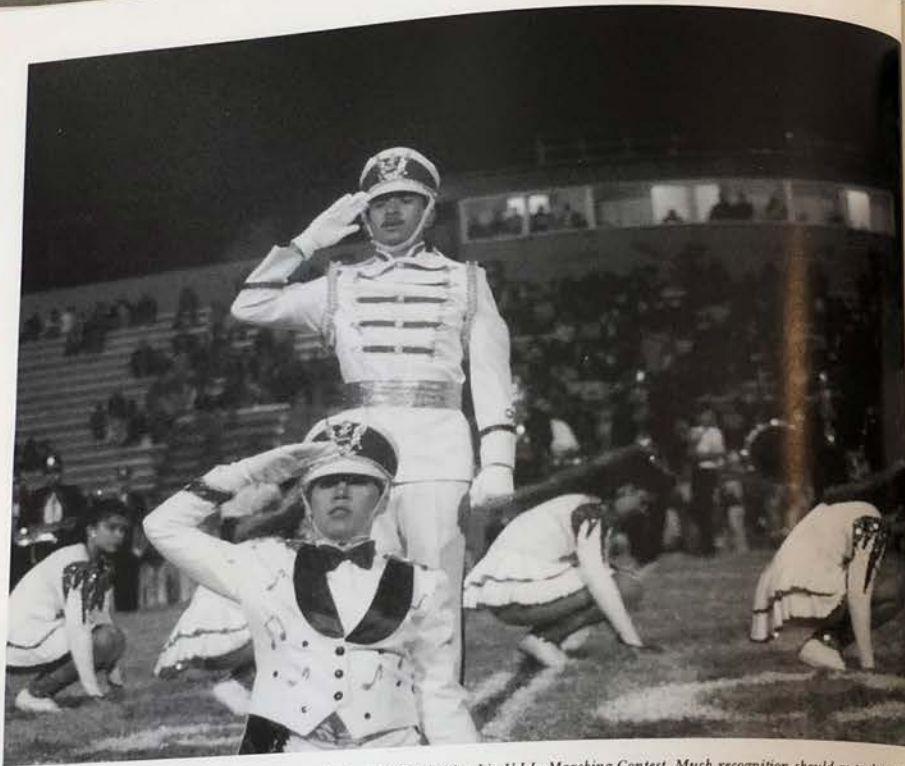

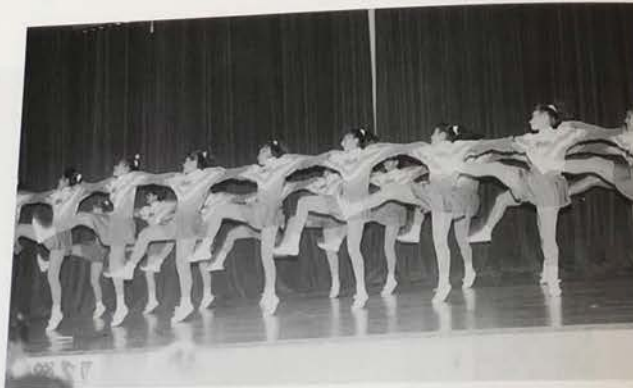
